Assessment and Clinical Understanding



MassHealth Children's Behavioral Health Initiative (CBHI) and the Child and Adolescent Needs and Strengths (CANS) Training Program has a training to improve assessment and case formulation skills. The Assessment & Clinical Understanding (ACU) training is designed for In-Home Therapy (IHT) clinicians, Intensive Care Coordinators (ICC), Outpatient therapists and their supervisors working with youth with behavioral health needs.

Goal:

The goal of the Assessment & Clinical Understanding initiative is to improve the overall quality of treatment for children, youth and their families.

Guiding Values:

Improving Assessment & Clinical Understanding plays a key role in improving In-Home Therapy (IHT), Intensive Care Coordination (ICC), and outpatient practice.

The CBHI Systems of Care (SOC) philosophy guides the development, delivery, and practice of CBHI services; including assessment and clinical formulation:

- Youth Guided and Family Driven: Services are driven by the needs and preferences of the child and family, developed in partnership with families, and accountable to families.
- **Strengths-Based:** Services are built on the strengths of the family and their community.
- **Collaborative and Integrated:** Services are coordinated and integrated across child-serving agencies and programs.
- Culturally Responsive: Services are responsive to the family's values, beliefs, norms, and to the socio-economic and cultural context.
- **Continuously Improving:** Service improvements reflect a culture of continuous learning, informed by data, family feedback, evidence, and best practice.

Training Description:

The Assessment & Clinical Understanding Training is an interactive and dynamic training that includes modules which can be used during supervision or be selfguided. Case studies are used to teach skills; videos demonstrate the skills; Stop & Apply exercises are used to apply the information learned, and sample assessment tools are provided. CEU's are offered upon completion.
