## Where will it take place?

This a FREE 12-hour training. The sessions occur every other week for 1 hour over 6 months. Sessions are held via Zoom video conferencing And will include Case Presentations with discussion amongst attendees. Each session will have a high yield slide didactic.

What topics are included?

The high yield didactics (or knowledge bursts) include:

- How to apply best practice care for those with autism and/or IDD who are experiencing a behavioral health concerns.
- How to communicate with these individuals and across systems involved in caring for them.
- What psychiatric and medical comorbidities, evidence-based interventions, and systems of care exist for those with autism and/or IDD.
