

Reminder

Verbalize and Point:

- * to demonstrate

- * 3 checks of the 5 rights

Testing

Tell staff:

- * DDS/DMH or D&S staff**
 - * May be in the testing room**
 - * Monitoring the 'tester'**

Record Keeping

Trainers must keep on file:

- * Verification form**
- * Pretest:**
 - * CBT score report**
 - * Medication administration demonstration**
 - * Transcription**
